

Hello Rio Valley,

The Fall 2010 Registration File is available in the Affinity Registration Program. Only MYSA has teams moved from spring into this falls file. The teams are not active so players can be added or dropped, team names can be changes, etc.

There will be changes in Rio Valley's select registration. Rio Valley, Corpus and Laredo to form the South Texas Alliance. Participating teams will be scheduled on a home and away basis. Super 2 teams will be playing in a Western District Schedule that will also be scheduled on a home and away basis. Division II will be scheduled valley wide.

Scheduling will be done through the Affinity Registration / Scheduling program. Therefore, we need to begin the registration process immediately. Registration will consist of two parts. The first part will be the team registration and then the player registration will be accomplished through you club.

Division One team registration may be done through <http://sotxalliance.org/> and look on the right hand side for registration link. Once updated, there will be three choices, Alliance Division One, Western District Super II and Rio Valley Division 2. In order to register the team, individuals will need their User ID and Password and to pay the team fee.

*Note: If your team is not listed for Fall 2010 that indicates that the team has not been moved into or formed in the Fall 2010 database. **You will need to contact your registrar immediately to get the team set up so that you can register.** The tournament will NOT be visible to teams registered in the Spring 2010 season as the two seasons are in different seasonal years and ages are calculated from a different base date. Again – **DO NOT** wait until the day before the deadline to initiate contact. It's summer and registrars occasionally do take a day off from soccer.*

Attached are the Rio Valley Commitment to Play Form, Division One and Super II Registration Instructions. In the Rio Valley Registration Information there is a team list from this past spring season with a recommendation of which division the teams should register for.
